

Determine the family size for the following examples:

- A. An unmarried pregnant 19 year old woman and her two year old adopted child live with the woman's grandparents.

Answer: Three – the pregnant woman, her unborn child, and her adopted child. Do not count the grandparents.

- B. An unmarried pregnant 16 year old woman lives with her mother and four siblings aged 13, 10, 8, and 5.

Answer: Seven – the pregnant woman, her unborn child, her mother and four siblings.

- C. A married 39 year old pregnant woman lives with her spouse and five children ages 20, 19, 16, 15, and 10.

Answer: Six – the pregnant woman, her unborn child, her spouse, and her children under age 18.

- D. An unmarried 18 year old woman pregnant with twins lives with her father, her step-mother, her father's children ages 16 and 14, her step-mother's child age 13, and her father's adoptive child age 9.

Answer: Three– the pregnant woman, her unborn twins.

- E. An unmarried pregnant woman lives on her own with her two year old child and her boyfriend.

Answer: Three – the pregnant woman, her unborn child, and her two year old child. Do not count her boyfriend.

- F. A married 17 year old pregnant woman with twins lives with her spouse and her parents.

Answer: Four – the pregnant woman, her unborn twins and her spouse. Do not count her parents.

Determine the gross monthly income for the following examples:

- A. An unmarried 17 year old pregnant woman is paid \$475/month from her job and receives additional \$150/month cash assistance from her parents. She lives with her grandmother who receives \$775/month social security benefits.

Answer: \$625 monthly (\$475+\$150). (Note: Family size is 2, the pregnant woman and her unborn child.)

- B. A married 25 year old pregnant woman is paid \$615/month from her job; her spouse is paid \$840/month from his job. The woman also receives \$150/month child support from her ex-spouse, for their 3 year old son. She, her son and her spouse live with her father-in-law; her father-in-law receives \$600/month VA benefits.

Answer: \$1,455/monthly (\$615+\$840). Do not count child support since it is not for the support of the pregnant woman. (Note: Family size is 4, the pregnant woman, her spouse, her first child, and the unborn child.)

- C. A 22 year old unmarried pregnant woman lives with her boyfriend, the father of her unborn child, and his child from a previous relationship. The boyfriend makes \$1,895/monthly from his job and receives \$300/monthly from his ex-girlfriend for the support of their child. The pregnant woman makes \$600/month from her part time job.

Answer: \$600 monthly. (Note: Family size is 2, the pregnant woman and unborn child.)

- D. A 17 year old married pregnant woman lives with her husband, her mother, and her younger sister. Her husband makes \$1000/monthly from his job and her mother makes \$1,100/monthly from her job and receives \$150/monthly for child support of the pregnant woman's younger sister. The pregnant woman doesn't have any income.

Answer: \$1000/ monthly. Because the pregnant woman is married, although she is under 18, don't count the parent's income or child support. (Note: Family size is 3, the pregnant woman, her husband, and her unborn child.)

- E. A pregnant woman is single with two children. Her gross monthly income is \$1,200. Her elderly aunt lives with her and receives \$550 a month from Social Security.

Answer: \$1,200. The aunt's income would not be counted. (Note: Family size is 4, the pregnant woman, her unborn child, and her two current children.)

- F. A pregnant woman is single with a 2 year old son. The only income is her son's child support of \$1000 per month.

Answer: \$0.00. Income of the applicant's child does not count. (Note: Family is 3, the pregnant woman, her son and her unborn child.)
